What is the Interstate 30 Planning and **Environmental Linkages Study?**

The Arkansas State Highway and Transportation Department (AHTD) is dedicated to working with our community to provide safe and reliable transportation solutions for Arkansas. As part of this mission, we are beginning the community discussion and visioning process for transportation improvements along I-30 in central Arkansas. The study area includes I-30 from I-40 in the north to I-530 in the south, including the Arkansas River Bridge, as well as I-40 from JFK Boulevard east to U.S. 67.

The Planning and Environmental Linkages (PEL) process will be followed for the I-30 study and will identify and document the transportation needs and potential improvements for the study area.

What is the PEL process?

The PEL process was established by the Federal Highway Administration (FHWA) to provide a more efficient process of evaluating a full range of transportation concepts and identifying the preferred improvements. This process allows early, planninglevel decisions to be carried forward to accelerate future National Environmental Policy Act (NEPA) activities.

What are the benefits of the PEL process?

In addition to informing and expediting the NEPA process, the PEL process will provide an opportunity for early coordination with the public as well as local, state, and federal agencies in a transparent and collaborative environment. By working together, alternatives and avoidance measures can be developed at a local level.

How long will the PEL process take?

The I-30 PEL study began in April 2014 and is anticipated to conclude in the summer of 2015. A report will be prepared to document the PEL process and recommended solutions.

Why is the PEL process needed for the **I-30 improvements?**

A feasibility study prepared jointly by AHTD and Metroplan in 2003 identified the need for transportation improvements for crossings of the Arkansas River. Some of the challenges identified for I-30 include:

- Increasing traffic congestion and travel times
- Inadequate roadway capacity
- Roadway safety and operational concerns
- Structural and functional roadway and bridge deficiencies

The PEL study will recommend a proposed solution or series of solutions to these challenges, as well as potential funding options.

How can the public get involved?

We understand that any proposed solution to the region's transportation needs must address issues and concerns from many stakeholders. Our process includes continuous outreach to engage the community throughout the study. AHTD will host future public meetings at locations that will be convenient to attendees from the study area. The public meetings will be held to provide project information and gather input from all those interested in the I-30 PEL Study.









Highway Build Bypass Route (-5)

Overview of the Public Meeting


Members of the I-30 PEL Study Team were available to greet public meeting participants as they entered the meeting. Attendees were provided informative handouts and seven distinct stations were set up to provide information on the PEL Study. Study Team staff were available at each station to answer questions. At the final station, meeting participants were invited to submit comments in the comment drop box. An audio recorder was also available for anyone wanting to make an oral statement. Meeting participants also learned the many ways in which they could make comments and obtain additional information





Study Area, Constraints Map and Timeline

Meeting participants were able to view the proposed I-30 PEL study area, review the environmental constraints (such as historic districts and structures, wetlands and parks) and review the PEL study timeline and where we are in that process. This station also presented the Purpose and Need of the project and the Study Goals



Level 1 Screening

Meeting participants were provided an overview of the Alternatives Screening Methodology, and then walked through the Level 1 screening process which evaluated and screened the Universe of Alternatives to a set of Preliminary Alternatives.



Level 2 Screening

Meeting participants were walked through the Level 2 screening process which evaluated and screened the Preliminary Alternatives to a set of Reasonable Alternatives to be carried forward to the Level 3 screening analysis.





Roll Plots and Typical Sections

This station allowed meeting participants to view the existing and proposed rights-of-way for the Reasonable Alternatives on aerial photograph. Typical Sections for each Reasonable Alternative were also presented. The three Reasonable Alternatives included an 8-lane C/D Scenario (3 Main Lanes + 1 C/D each direction); a 10-Lane Scenario (5 Main Lanes each direction); and a 10-Lane C/D Scenario (3 Main Lanes + 2 C/D Lanes each direction). Study Team members were available to answer questions. Meeting attendees were informed that Interchange and ramp locations will be determined during the Level 3 process.

Subject: Citizen Comment Form re I-30 improvements

I do not think it is acceptable to consider either 8 or 10 lanes for Interstate 30. For one thing, the Metroplan Board for many years has taken a stand against more than 6 lanes, instead favoring the development of a more multi-modal system. I wholeheartedly agree with this stance. For another thing, I know you have done traffic forecasts, but the overall trend is to less, not more driving, for a variety of reasons I am sure you have read as much as I have. I know Central Arkansas is growing population-wise, but that is still a lot of pavement if the VMT trend holds. I would rather have congestion that makes people reconsider jumping in their cars and to consider transit, than to over-build roads.

But more personally, just as a driver, I don't want driving in Little Rock to feel like driving in Atlanta. I much prefer that we find other ways to accommodate the traffic, like building a new bridge at Chester Street and funneling some of the traffic out through North Little Rock. I have read that your travel demand model doesn't show that this will help much, but I am not convinced. The Little Rock/North Little Rock area needs several more bridges so the traffic can spread out. People would not use I-30 for local traffic if they had viable alternatives. I do not think the Collector/Distributor lanes are a viable alternative.

These comments are related to the AHTD Job CA0602 (I-30 PEL study), public meeting #3 on January 29, 2015.

Of the three options presented at Meeting #3 on 1/29/15, I very much prefer the 8-Lane C/D Scenario. I can barely stomach the 10-Lane C/D Scenario, and I absolutely abhor the 10-Lane Scenario. But frankly, I doubt that the AHTD is taking a vote on this issue.

I do not think we need more through lanes to solve a problem that exists for maybe ten hours a week. This afternoon (a Tuesday), at about 4:50 PM, I drove from Crystal Hill, traveling east on I-40, turned right onto I-30 West, traveled through the downtown and turned right on I-630 West. I never went slower than 40 MPH, and people were passing me. It was surely the heart of rush hour, and I never encountered a problem.

I have much more difficulty during rush hour traveling in the city, crossing the Broadway bridge, trying to travel east to west through the downtown. Except when there is a wreck, I do not have problems on the freeways downtown. I wish that AHTD had a broader concept of the "T" in their name, and wasn't so dependent on building bigger and wider highways to solve every transportation problem. What I think we need more than additional through lanes downtown (where people who live there will have to breathe more auto pollution), is more public transit, better on- and off-ramps with the freeways, improved traffic lights, smarter intersections, well-paved streets. I'd rather see this money spent on the Broadway bridge and replacing the NLR Main Street bridge over the viaduct downtown.

To me, building more lanes primarily means that a single wreck can bottle up more traffic. Over the past 40 years I've seen that result on every one of your expansion projects.
