

I-630 Construction Progress



Bridge Demolition Over Rodney Parham

To continue work on widening Interstate 630, Rodney Parham Road beneath the interstate was temporarily closed in early January.

This road closure allowed crews to perform bridge demolition work, including deck and beam removal.

Throughout the widening project, neighborhoods adjacent to the interstate will experience nighttime and daytime noise impacts.



Recent and Upcoming Construction

- Asphalt paving at Rodney Parham Road on-ramp to eastbound I-630.
- Concrete paving at Rodney Parham on-ramp to eastbound I-630.
- Drilling and installing noise barrier shafts, setting posts, and grading slopes.
- Grading I-630 main lanes in the area of John Barrow Road.
- Grading at ramps for John Barrow Road and Rodney Parham Road.
- Continued retaining wall construction throughout the project.
- Drainage work throughout the corridor.
