

I-630 Construction Progress



Recent and Upcoming Construction

- Concrete paving eastbound between Baptist Health and John Barrow Road, as well as the I-630 eastbound off-ramp at John Barrow Road.
- Asphalt work eastbound between Baptist Health and John Barrow Road, as well as several ramps at John Barrow Road.
- Grading I-630 main lanes eastbound between John Barrow Road to east of Rodney Parham, and westbound between Hughes Street and Rodney Parham.
- Pouring the bridge deck at Rock Creek.
- Continuing with bridge construction at Rodney Parham Road.
- Continuing retaining wall construction throughout the project.
- Installing noise wall panels along I-630 east of Hughes Street.

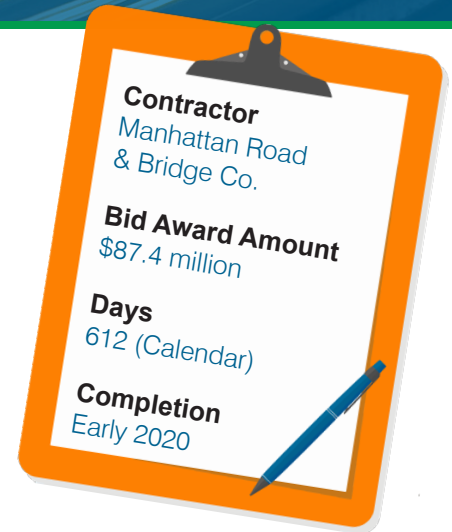


Construction Cameras

Construction traffic cameras are installed along I-630 at John Barrow Road (Exit 6B) and the South Hughes Street overpass.
