

I-630 Construction Progress



Recent and Upcoming Construction

- Eastbound and westbound I-630 traffic are shifting toward the outside lanes and onto newly constructed pavement.
- Pavement work on John Barrow Road from the I-630 overpass north toward Cloverhill Road.
- Surface preparations and painting on the South Hughes Street and John Barrow Road structures.
- Continued construction work at Rodney Parham and Rock Creek structures.
- Concrete removal and replacement within the median.
- Asphalt work in multiple areas within the construction zone.
- Grading and concrete work for paved ditches.
- Ground and barrier-mounted lighting throughout the work zone.
- Continued drainage, excavation, and retaining wall work.
- Noise wall installation along westbound I-630 west of Rodney Parham Road overpass.
